# COVID Protocol for Colorado State EMS Conference

"BSI, scene safe." We now **require all attendees**, **sponsors**, **exhibitors**, **speakers**, **staff**, **and volunteers to submit proof of COVID vaccination in order to attend the conference**. Here are a few ways you can submit your vaccination record:

1) Upload a copy while registering. If you have already registered, contact us with a copy and we can update your registration record. You will receive a discount code and link to register in a couple of weeks via email.

2) Upload a copy during the session selection process

3) Bring a photocopy with you to provide during on-site registration

Anyone needing an exemption due to a medical condition, disability or religious belief will need to complete the exemption form and bring the signed form along with proof of a negative COVID test (molecular, PCR or antigen) that was administered by an official testing center to the event. Test must be taken no more than 48 hours prior to arrival at the conference center. Home testing kit results will not be accepted for entry.

# **Colorado Receives Grant through Rural Expansion Program**

The Health Resources and Services Administration Emergency Medical Services for Children (EMSC) Program has announced four supplemental grant recipients through its State Partnership Rural Expansion Program:

- Colorado EMSC
- Kentucky EMSC
- Tennessee EMSC
- Wisconsin EMSC

The funded programs respond to gaps in the readiness to care for children in prehospital EMS and emergency departments in rural, remote, and/or tribal areas. The programs focus on the following objectives:

- Increase the number of hospitals in rural, remote, and/or tribal communities that are recognized by a state, regional, or territorial pediatric medical recognition program; or
- Increase the number of pediatric emergency care coordinators in rural, remote, and/or tribal EMS agencies.

The State of Colorado is seeking individuals interested in serving on the Emergency Medical Practice Advisory Council to apply for the following open positions on the council.


- <u>An emergency medical service provider certified or licensed at</u> any level who is actively involved in the provision of emergency <u>medical services</u>

## **Report EMS Sentinel Events**

In the continued effort to improve EMS provider and patient safety, the SEMTAC Safety Committee asks EMS providers to <u>report</u> sentinel events using EVENT (EMS Voluntary



Event Notification Tool). EVENT is a platform that allows an individual or organization to anonymously report misses and near-miss occurrences, resulting in system improvements.



#### **Colorado EMS Provider Licensing**

Converting your Colorado EMS provider certification to a license is optional. If you choose not to convert your certification to a license, you will remain certified and will be able to renew your certification as you always have. Converting to a license does not change your scope of practice or the duration of your certification/license. For those wishing to be licensed, you can convert your certification by completing the license conversion form found in your OATH account or by choosing the license option in your next renewal application. There is no additional cost associated with license conversion.
