- **Description**: This flow chart outlines the process of exposure to a potential COVID-19 patient, **REMEMBER** assume **ALL** patients are positive.
- *Symptoms of COVID-19: Cough, Shortness of Breath, Fever ≥ 100.0°F, Body Aches, Diarrhea, Headache, Sore Throat, Sneezing, Runny Nose
- Occ. Health, or Public Health
- Wear mask around close contacts & isolate

Employee May Return to Work

• At least 7 days since onset of symptoms **AND** NO symptoms for 72 hours without medications

- Confirmed diagnosis (Dx) for an illness other than COVID-19 such as strep, influenza, culture confirmed bacterial illness or another confirmable virus
 - Viral: Symptom free for 24 consecutive hours WITHOUT medicinal intervention.
 - o Bacterial: Symptom improvement for 24 consecutive hours after beginning antibiotics.
